It is our desire to see young people grow in an understanding of God might use them to serve His church. Also, we want them to see some examples from God's Word and in the church today of people given to caring for the local body. For that reason, this year's them is "Answering the Call".

Qualifications

To qualify for this year's youth trip there is 2 parts to complete. The first part is to answer 5 questions about <u>one</u> of the six people in Scripture listed below. Those questions are shown on the following page with space for answers to be given. The second part is to interview a person in leadership at your local church, one of the leaders' wives, or any of your church's Sunday School Teachers. Sunday School Teachers at each church would include Daniel Holaday, Shawna Holaday, Hannah Sciranko, Sue Vogel, or Shirley Kaiser. Again, the other options are an elder or deacon in your local church, or one of their wives. This part comes with 6 questions, and those are found on page 3 of this document.

THE SIX PEOPLE TO CHOOSE FROM IN SCRIPTURE: Mary, Esther, Elisha, Abraham, Noah, or Paul

A group of youth can study a person from Scripture together or even interview a leader together. However, each must write their own answers. Once completed they must return the document to Bill Holaday, Shawna Holaday, or Pastor Josh.

<u>Once completed</u>, a youth has the opportunity to invite a friend outside of the two churches to come. We encourage you to take advantage of this.
